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- Day 1 Arrive in Châteauneuf-du-Pape before 2pm.
- Set out on a tour “discovering the vineyards” on your own with visits and tastings
- Settle into your 3* hotel or Guesthouse
- Day 2 Go on a “wine and winemaker’s picnic” tour on your own at the foot of the Ventoux
- Visit the Roman theatre in Orange
- Dinner at your hotel or Guesthouse
- Day 3 An electric bike ride discovering the vineyards

DAY - 1

Arrive by your own means at your 3* hotel (or guesthouse) in Châteauneuf-du-Pape before 2pm. Leave your luggage and get your passport back!

Take your car to visit the Châteauneuf-du-Pape vineyards and the charming village that gave the appellation its name. Your passionate guide at each estate will explain the wines, grape varieties and terroir, and then invite you to taste the wines of course!

Explore the panoramic route through the Châteauneuf-du-Pape vineyards and go for a walk through the village streets thanks to your A la Française roadbook. Enjoy a panoramic view of the Rhône valley from the ruins of the Pope's summer residence.

You'll know everything there is to know about Châteauneuf-du-Pape, the grand Cru famous for its blended wines!

Go back to the hotel and relax in your double room.

Evening free.



DAY - 2

After breakfast, still in your car, head off to meet passionate producers in a rich terroir at the foot of the Ventoux, the Provence giant!

Start your A la Française morning with a walk through the vines of an outstanding wine estate at the foot of Mont Ventoux.

Then visit the wine cellar and learn more about how their wines are made. Finish your visit using your five senses to taste five wines (1 white, 1 rosé and 3 red). A passionate wine expert will explain all the techniques and secrets to tasting wine like a professional!

After the visit, enjoy a picnic of local products and one of the estate's wines on the château terrace under hundred-year-old plane trees ... An idyllic lunch! You can stay and go for a walk in the château's grounds and enjoy the wonderful view.

In the afternoon, head to Orange, a city of art and history, to discover its exceptional heritage.

Immerse yourself in Roman civilisation with a magnificent view of its **Triumphal Arch**. Then admire the majestic **Roman theatre** (UNESCO World Heritage site), considered to be one of the best preserved of the time (admission included).

Go back to your hotel.

Relax by the pool, before going to dinner at the Sommelierie, where you'll enjoy a delicious 3-course meal with a glass of Châteauneuf-du-Pape wine per person.



DAY - 3

After breakfast, go to one of our partner estates to explore the vineyard on an electric bike.

Explore the appellation's different terroirs over a 16km circuit. Remember the altitude is 100m! The route may be challenging in some places for those not used to cycling. But don't worry, as we have electric bikes to help!



Recharge your batteries at the midway point by taking a break to have a picnic on the "Etang salé" natural site. *Picnic baskets are provided on request.*

Take advantage of a wine tasting when you get back.

After the wonderful time you've had discovering the Rhône valley, your visit has now come to an end.
