Day 1: Welcome to Provence – Pernes les Fontaines

After settling into your hotel, head off on your bike to see what the village and its surroundings are like. Cycle along country roads, stopping to taste local wine, and visit the vintage bicycle museum and old village centre. Warm up your legs and get used to the bikes with this first circuit.

Distance: 25 km

Level: Easy



Day 2: From Pernes les Fontaines to southern Côtes du Rhône and Vaison la Romaine

Today's itinerary takes you into the southern Côtes du Rhône wine country. Stop off on the way in Carpentras, the Comtat Venaissin capital, then head towards beautiful Vaison la Romaine and its old mediaeval town and impressive Roman vestiges. Stop off on the way to see one of our wine-making friends, who will introduce you to wines from southern Côtes du Rhône.

Distance: 45 km

Level: Easy / Intermediary

Day 3: From Vaison la Romaine to Mont Ventoux

This morning start pedalling your bikes towards the Comtat Venaissin and the foot of Mont Ventoux. You'll enjoy the ride along superb panoramic roads in the foothills of the Dentelles de Montmirail. Visit the Châteaux du Barroux before you come to the lively village of Bedoin, devoted to cycling, and the starting point of the mythical ride up Mont Ventoux.

Distance: 38 km or 49 km **Level:** Easy / Intermediary



Day 4: Gentle ride in the Comtat Venaissin

On the last day, enjoy the Comtat Venaissin following a route through the vines and fields of cherry trees to explore the real Provence. Don't miss having a picnic at one of our favourite winemakers, or tasting the delicious nougat made by artisan nougat maker Silvain to end your stay on a sweet note.

Distance: 35 km or 47 km **Level:** Easy / Intermediary
